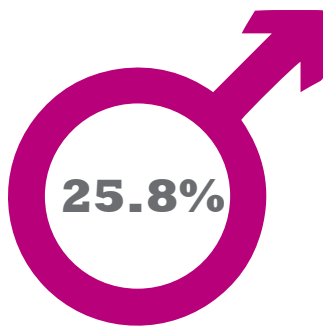
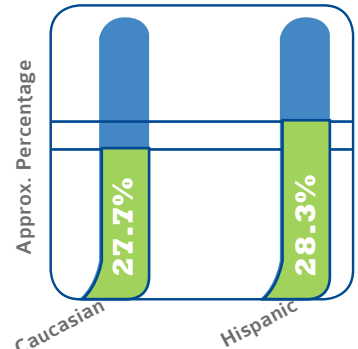
ADULT OBESITY FACTS:

Obesity affects more than 29.8% of Alaskans.



Alaska is ranked 26/51 in states impacted by obesity.

Alaskans Affected by Obesity by Race



More than 25.8% of male Alaskans are affected by obesity.



More than 25.5% of female Alaskans are affected by obesity.



The age group most affected by obesity in Alaska is 65+ (34.7%).
