

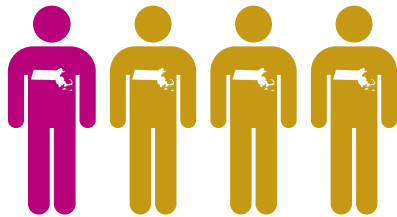

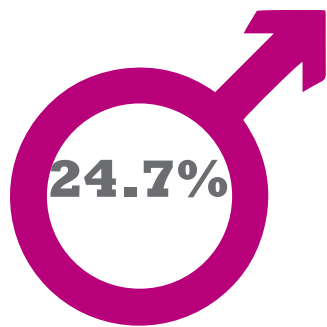
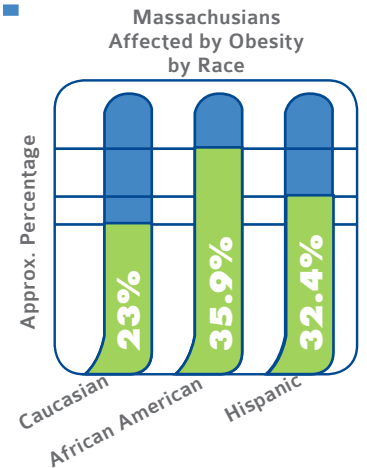


ADULT OBESITY FACTS:

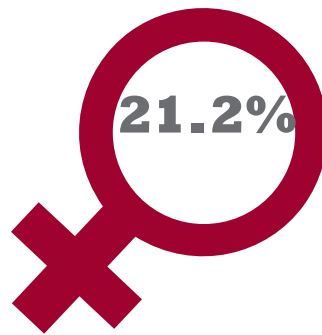
Obesity affects more than 24.3% of Massachusians.



Massachusetts is ranked 46/51 in states impacted by obesity.



More than 24.7% of male Massachusians are affected by obesity.



More than 21.2% of female Massachusians are affected by obesity.



The age group most affected by obesity in Massachusetts is 45-64 (29.9%).

Massachusetts ranks 35th in adults with Type 2 Diabetes (8.9%).

The total cost of obesity in Massachusetts

\$33.53 BILLION

The cost of obesity for Medicare in Massachusetts

\$6.02 BILLION

The cost of employment for the population with obesity is

\$18.76 BILLION

more than the normal weight population.
